How you can reach us: 1st step: Take the subway: Line "A" direction Anagnina and get off at Anagnina Station 2nd step: Take the Bus: Line 20 express to all the Schools. Direction: via Cambellotti (Tor Bella Monaca) and get off at Lettere e Filosofia The Macroarea di Lettere e Filosofia is made by two symmetrical buildings called Edificio A and Edificio B. EDIFICIO "A": It's the building where teaching activities take place. Most of the classrooms are located along the corridors of the ground floor. In building A students will find also a reading room, a Language Laboratory and a computer room. The Erasmus Office is located at the -1 floor at Room SO5.
