- Germany is located in the heart of **Europe**
- City of **Mainz**
  - Home to almost 220,000 residents
  - **Capital** and largest city in Rhineland-Palatine
  - Rhine-Main area, close to **Frankfurt** & Wiesbaden
  - Historic wine region and part of „Great Wine Capitals“
  - Headquarter to Germany's second-largest TV station ZDF
  - 30 min to **Germany's largest airport** (Frankfurt)

# JOHANNES GUTENBERG-UNIVERSITY

- Founded in 1477
- Named after Johannes Gutenberg, inventor of the printing press
- One of Germany's largest universities (33,000 students)
- Approx. 4,400 academics, including 560 professors, teach and research in over 150 institutes and clinics
- Almost all departments located on one campus
- More than 100 partner universities worldwide

# BENEFITS FOR STUDENTS AT JGU

- **NO TUITION**; semester fee approx. € 360
- Student accommodations (exchange students applying in due time are guaranteed a room in the students' residences!)
- Low-priced food in dining halls and cafeterias
- Semester ticket for Germany-wide public transportation (included in semester fee!)
- Huge selection of (mostly free) sport activities offered by the university
- Free computer use and internet access on campus

# IS IT EXPENSIVE TO LIVE IN MAINZ?

- You should generally calculate **approx. € 810 per month** to cover your accommodation, health insurance and everyday expenses.\*
- The semester fee (approx. **€ 360 per semester**) includes Germany-wide public transportation.

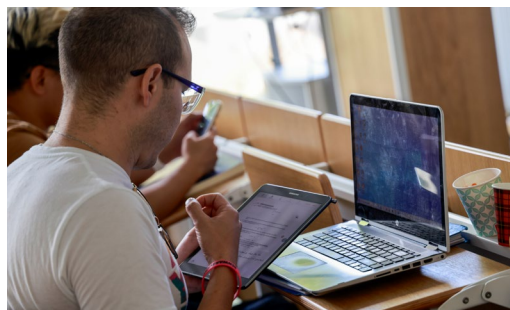

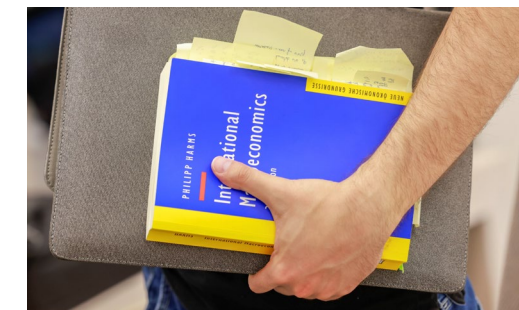
