





REGISTERING FOR <u>CLASSES</u>



- Register yourself using the online tool **JOGU-StINe**
- Pay attention to the course registration periods:

→ Monday 16 October (1 pm) to Thursday 19 October (1 pm)
 → Monday 23 October (1 pm) to Friday 27 October (9 pm)


- Registering for classes ≠ Registering for exams:
 - → Registration for the courses is a prerequisite for participation in exams!
 - → However, registration for a course does not oblige you to register for and take part in the associated exam!
 - → Attention: Whenever you are asked for a "TAN", you are registering to the course and the exam at the same time!

JOGU-StINe step-by-step tutorial

- Enter the JOGU-StINe homepage: <u>https://jogustine.uni-mainz.de</u>
- Login, using your ZDV username and password 2.
- Use the navigation in the menu on the left: 3.



- Choose between Bachelor and Master classes
- Click through the various categories displayed beneath until you 5. get to the modules that you would like to register for




REGISTERING FOR <u>CLASSES</u>

Please take care to always register for the **whole module**! = "package" of lectures/tutorials




For some courses, you will have to click "register" 3 times: once for the module, once for the lecture, and once for the tutorial.



REGISTERING FOR EXAMS



- Register yourself using the online tool JOGU-StINe
- Pay attention to the exam registration period!
 - → Keep your eyes open for the information email including the dates of the registration period!
- Usually you will need a TAN (transaction number) to register for examinations (you receive your first TAN list via mail to your new students mail account)
- If you haven't received a TAN list yet, you can <u>generate a new list</u> here:



RETAKE EXAMS

- If you don't pass an exam in the first attempt, you can take part in the repeat exam offered a few weeks later.
- Registration deadline for a retake exam: **one week prior** to the date of the retake exam.
- You are **not** automatically registered for the retakes! If you would like to attend a retake exam, you
 have to register yourself again via **JOGU-StINe**.

It is strictly necessary that you are **still enrolled** at JGU at the date of the retake exam!

For some students, the dates of the retakes overlap with periods of mandatory presence at their home university.

In this **exceptional case**, a <u>special retake</u> may be offered only with the consent of the JGU faculty members. Please find out as soon as possible whether your presence at your home university at the time of a regular retake at JGU Mainz is absolutely required and get in touch with the "Studienbüro"/International Office GSME as soon as possible!

How do I get my Transcript of Records (ToR)?

Before you request your ToR:

- ✓ All of your **exam results** have to show up in JOGU-StINe
- ✓ You have received the signature on your **"Confirmation of Departure"** (Erasmus)

You then have to request your ToR via **e-mail**

→ We will send you an e-mail with the exact instructions on how to order your ToR at the end of the semester!
