- 1 Higher National Institute of Teaching and Education (INSPE)






III. The EUR ELMI – Portail Economie Gestion

IV. Steps of your application

1.Nomination

• Your home university will send your nomination to your International Relations Service.

Documents to prepare

• You will receive an e-mail from the International Relations Service to explain you how to proceed for the application.

Arrival at Nice

• Contact us to get an appointment for your administrative and pedagogical registrations.



Academic residences (private or public) are independent from the University (see diapositive about housing)





V. Documents to provide

- Copy of « Lettre de nomination officielle sur un programme d'échange » from your home university
- Copy of the 2023-2024 student card or school certificate from the home university
- « Fiche d'Identification de l'Etudiant Entrant» completed
- Application form « inscription administrative » completed
- Copy of passport for non UE citizens or identity card VALID for UE citizens
- Transcript of Records
- Certification of level B2:
 - In French if you take courses in French
 - In English if you take courses in English
 - In French and English if you take courses in French and in English
- Proof of **Health insurance** for the whole period of mobility :
 - European Health Insurance Card for UE/EEE or a proof of health insurance if you do not come from UE
 - Form SE 401 Q106 for Quebecers
 - Students from another country (Ex. Turkey) have to register to the French Health insurance as soon as they arrive in Nice.
- Learning Agreement BEFORE the Mobility signed and stamped by your home university







VI. Learning Agreement BEFORE the mobility

Be careful to respect the semester of your mobility:

- > Semestre 1: courses named « Semestre 1, 3 or 5»
- > Semestre 2: courses named « Semestre 2, 4 or 6 »





- All these steps are mandatory.







XII. Housing



Public Academic residences are administered by <u>CROUS (Centre Régional des Œuvres Universitaires et Scolaires) de Nice-Toulon,</u> <u>NOT by UNIVERSITY</u>. However, we will help you with the process of application for a room.

If you wish to apply for an universitary room of the CROUS, you have to apply for a Dossier Social étudiant on the following link: https://www.messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr/envole/enregistrement

Once your file created, a provisional INE (National Student Identifier) will be given to you. Next, you will have to communicate this INE in the Application form.

We will then communicate your information to the CROUS, and we will keep you informed as soon as we have an answer regarding the allocation of rooms.

Beware! Application to an universitary room does not guarantee to get one. Please keep on looking for an accommodation on your side.

It is also possible to search for an **individual accomodation**. You will have to do this research before your arrival in Nice. **The search for accomodation is not easy:** rents are high, places are rares (**from 550€/ month**, depending on the type of accomodation sought).

XIII. French courses

- The Direction of international development and Europe offers French courses for exchange students.
- These courses are optional and do not earn ECTS credits. It doesn't have to appear on your Learning Agreement.
- If you wish to register, you have to indicate your current level, with a certification if possible.
- You will have to indicate in the Application Form if you wish to follow these courses or not.







XIV. Your arrival to the Campus Saint Jean d'Angely

Administrative registration

- You must go to the International Relations Service (office 254/256 see opening times p3)
- Bring your Certificate of Arrival only if your home university required it
- Non UE citizens have to register to the French Health insurance as soon as they arrive in Nice if they do not have an European Health Insurance Card. TERASMUS+ Frasmus+
