Below you find brief instructions on how Incoming Students at the JGU Mainz can find out about the courses that are available for them at the Department of Business and Economics. The course catalogue displayed here, is updated every Semester. Therefore, you can see the available courses regardless of when your studies start. However, maybe not all courses offered in the last semester will be available again in the future.

1. First, you have to click on the following Link leading to the University web page Jogustine: <https://jogustine.uni-mainz.de>

2. Now you should see this page:

After clicking on the course catalogue, you need to select the semester in which you will be studying in Mainz. As an example, we will use “Winter Semester 2025/26”.

Once you have selected your semester, you can choose your field of study. In our case it is “Faculty03 – Law Management, and Economics”.

Next you need to distinguish between “Law” and “Business and Economics”. In our case it is “Business and Economics”.

Then you have to choose the sixth point in the list: “**For Incoming Exchange Students**”.
